The show is an exhibition of things made and grown in the village and is held every year at the end of August or beginning of September. The first show took place in 1973 and was the idea of John Bidder, rector of Mepal at that time. Since then it has become a popular event on the village calendar and on show day the hall is filled with produce, craftwork and people.



All villagers are invited to enter and cups are awarded for the best items in the different classes, but it's much more a celebration of village life than a competition. A programme that explains how to take part is delivered to each household at the beginning of August.



The show is run by a committee of residents who also organise the garden competition.
