(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)

ORDER 2017/368

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Chatteris Road, Mepal as lies between junctions with Engine Bank and Mepal Bypass.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via A142 - A10 - A14 - A141 - A142 and vice versa.

The Order is made to facilitate bridge joint replacement and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 24 July 2017 and continue until these works have finished or on the 23 January 2017 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 24 July and 5 August 2017.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.

Application for Temporary Road Closure at Chatteris Road, Mepal

Your application for the above Order has been approved, and will come into operation on 24 July 2017.

All necessary legal procedures have been attended to by ourselves, the emergency services will be informed in due course and you will be invoiced accordingly.

Will you please note that the proper signing of the highway obstruction in accordance with Traffic Safety regulations and the adequate signing of the alternative route are entirely your responsibility. You MUST place Notices at least 1050mm by 750mm at each end of the highway to be closed at least 14 days prior to the closure informing the travelling public of the start and end dates of the closure.

All signing must be carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Local Highways Officer (Telephone Number 0345 045 5212) in whose area the work lies and you should make early arrangements to discuss the signing with them.
